### Tree Marker

The Algonquin Forestry Authority (AFA) is seeking Tree Markers for the 2025 season. The AFA is the Ontario Crown Agency responsible for sustainable forest management in Algonquin Provincial Park. Our responsibilities include harvesting and distribution of wood products to mills in communities adjacent to the park, as well as forest management planning, silviculture, and compliance monitoring.

**Positions and Locations:** Tree Markers – Pembroke, Whitney/Madawaska, ON  
**Approximate Start Date:** May 2025  
**Duration:** 26 weeks (with possibility of extension)  
**Salary:** \$21.20/hr. - \$25.02/hr. (40-hour work week, plus 4% vacation pay)

#### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

Working as part of a crew on tree marking projects in the Algonquin Park Forest. Other projects such as silviculture layout and contractor supervision may also be assigned.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

The candidates should have demonstrated skills including dendrology, aerial photo interpretation, map reading, and knowledge of the silvics of the Great Lakes/St. Lawrence tree species. **Tree marking certification and a valid Ontario driver's license are preferred.**

Successful applicants are required to work in inclement weather and walk on uneven terrain, with exposure to dust, heavy equipment, biting insects, bears, and poison ivy at project sites. The work will often require staying in bunkhouse trailers in remote locations during the work week. Lodging and food or meal allowance are provided when crews are in the field.
